

Modification Application for the Addition of a Byway Open to All Traffic in the Parishes of Brancaster and Burnham Market

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Good Afternoon

In 2021 Norfolk County Council was in receipt of an application to record a byway open to all traffic on the definitive map and statement in the parishes of Brancaster and Burnham Market. The route is known as Staithe Road and is shown by a bold black line on the attached plan.

A byway open to all traffic is a highway over which the public is entitled to travel on foot, horseback, bicycle and mechanically propelled vehicles (cars, vans and tractors etc.), but which is used by the public mainly for walking or riding. The road is already recorded on NCC's List of Streets as an unclassified road, but if successful this application will enable it to be recorded on the definitive map, giving it a legal status.

I am writing to the relevant parish councils to ask if you have any comments or observations you would like to make with regards to how the route is used. Are you aware of regular vehicular use? Or is the route more often used by those on foot, horseback or bicycle?

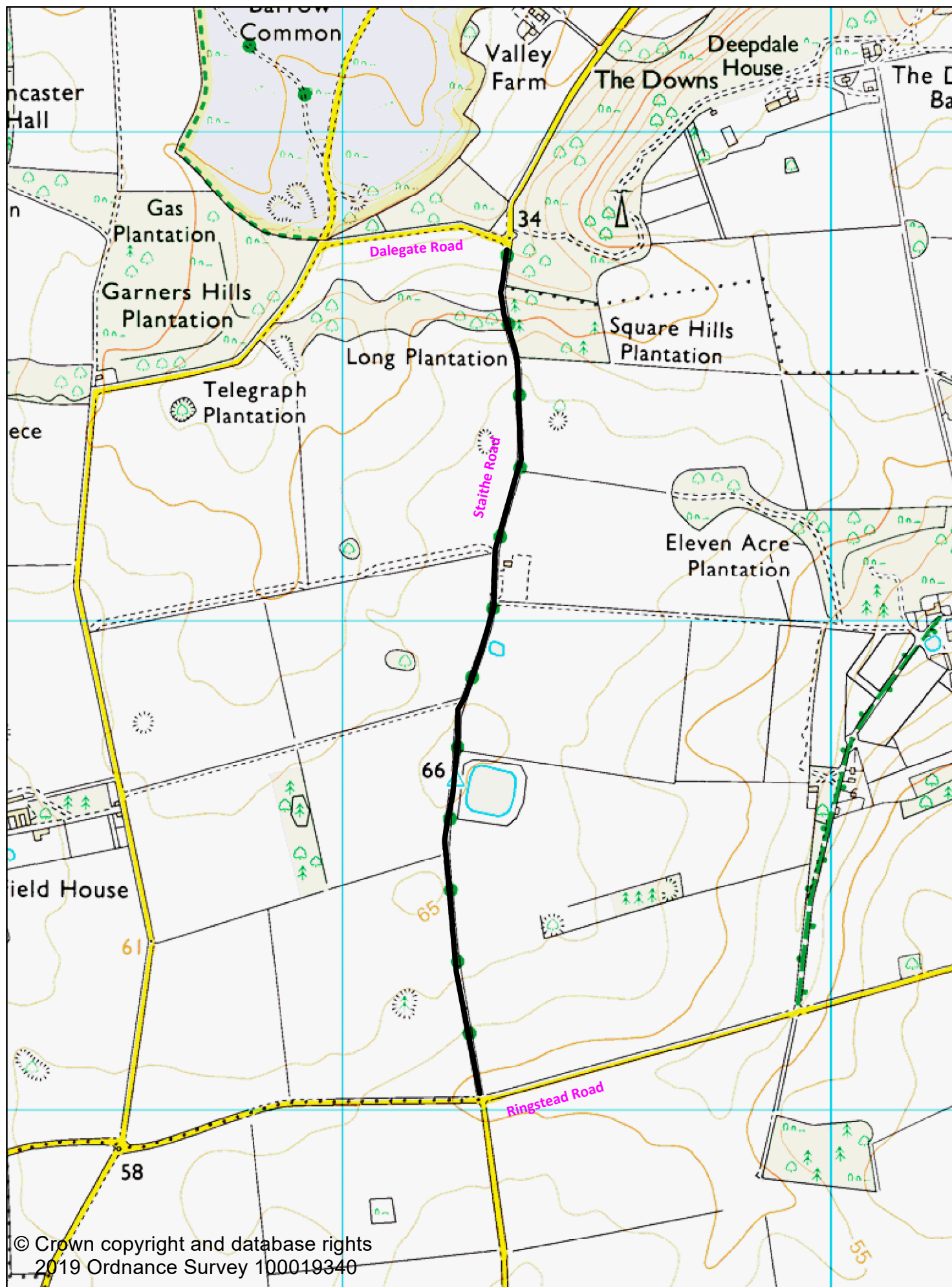
