

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (WTRO6895) affecting the B1155 Wells Road from its junction with the C96 Mill Lane for 340 metres westwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Burnham Overy to facilitate pole testing and tree cutting works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 09:30 and 15:30 on the 24<sup>th</sup> July 2026, but may continue to be closed until the 4<sup>th</sup> September 2026 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Burnham Road, Model Farm Road, Main Road, Wells Road, Tower Road, Bellamys Lane, Overy Road, Mill Road (Burnham Norton, Holkham, Burnham Market, Burnham Overy, Burnham Thorpe).

The works promoter for this closure is: BT.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 4<sup>th</sup> September 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

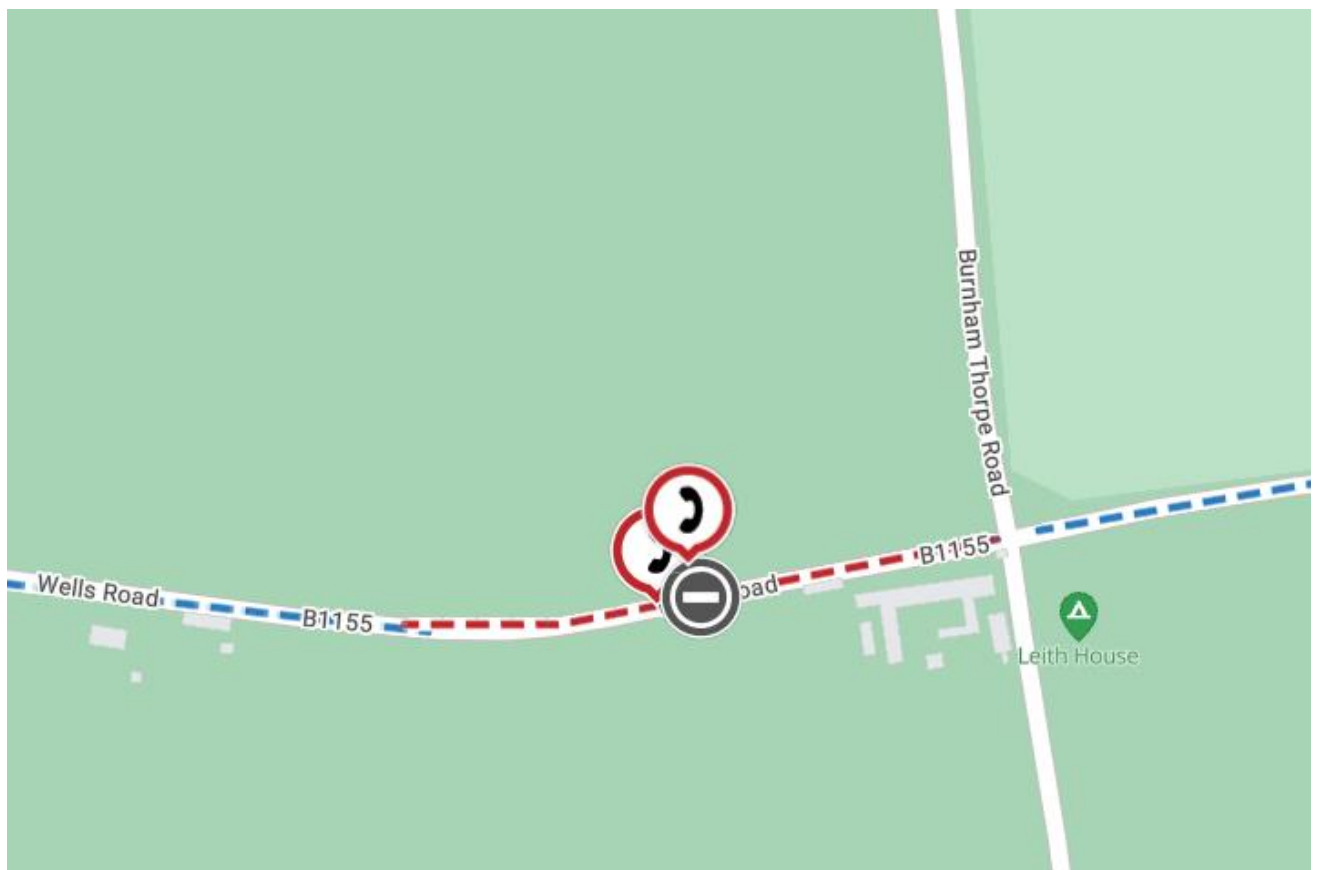
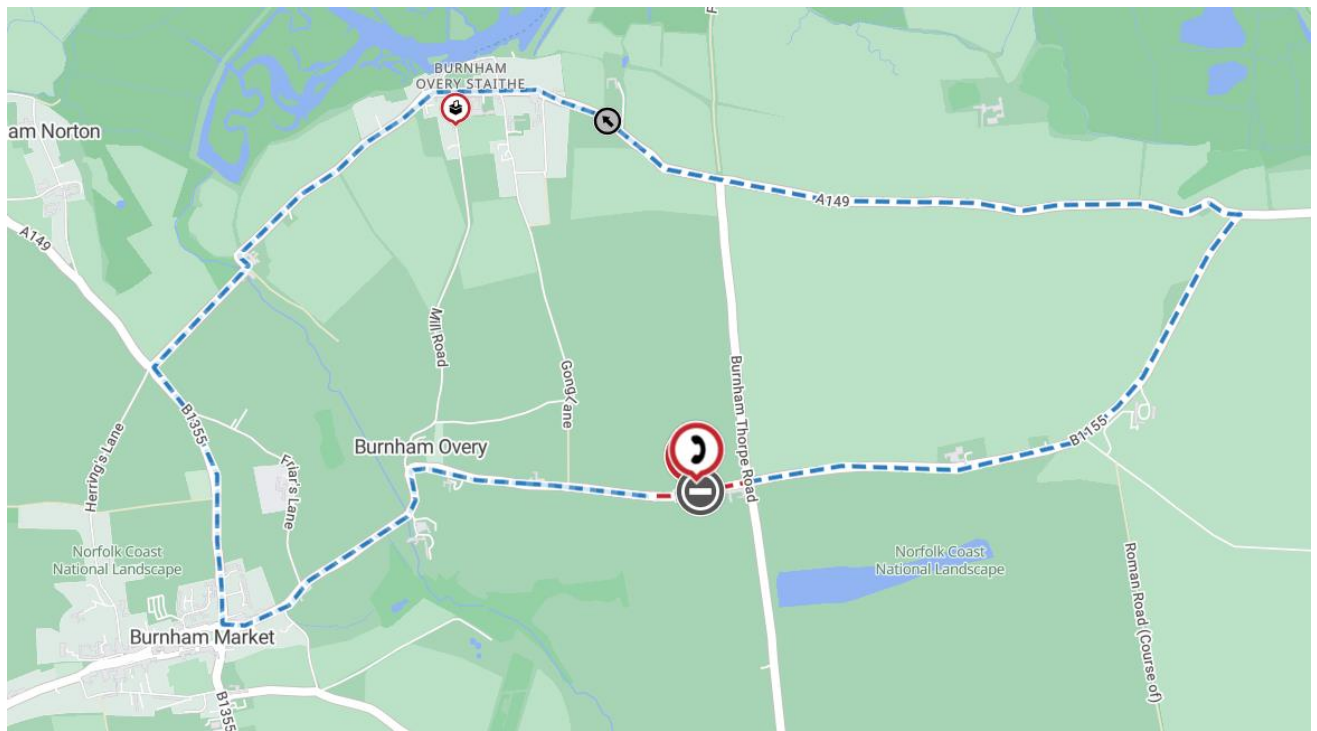
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
